INSTRUCTIONS

5. [Variety] If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, Parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

6. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

7. [Event Class] Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

8. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entries

- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check. Any returned check must be made good by cash or money order before the dog will be allowed into the ring.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.
- Please print or type all information on the entry form.
- Please show only dog's AKC titles on the entry form.
- Telegraph, telephone, emailed and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the trial. All entries must be made on official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the Agreement and Rules.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or email (beverly.hutchinson@gtri.gatech.edu) prior to the closing date.

Refunds

- No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the closing date, except in the cases of bitches that come into season. In those cases, refunds of valid entries may be obtained by providing the Trial Secretary with a veterinarian's certificate verifying that the bitch came into season after the closing date. The certificate may be mailed, provided the postmark is no later than the date prior to the day of the trial, or delivered by hand to the Trial Secretary before the start of the trial.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee.
- Entry fees will not be refunded because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization, if it is impossible to open or to complete the trial.
- Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
- If, in the opinion of the host club, the well being of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.
- Cancelled entries will be charged a \$10 processing fee.

Awards and Trophies

Judging Procedures

- Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

Pre-Novice Class – ENTRIES LIMITED TO 15 DOGS

The Pre-Novice Class shall be for dogs that have not received a third qualifying score in a Novice Class prior to the closing of the trial. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. However, if a person has handled more than one dog in the first four exercises, that person must provide a handler for the additional dog in the same Group Exercise. All exercises will be scored as in the Novice Class, except the dogs will perform all exercises on leash, which should be 6 feet in length.

WILD CARD OPEN – ENTRIES LIMITED TO 10 DOGS

The Wild Card Open class is for any dog capable of performing the Open exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in another class or classes at the trial. The Open exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Open A class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. (Good, yes, nice, super, great, attaboy, are some examples of praise that would be allowed.) Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or Judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The exercises will be performed in the same order as in the regular Open A class. The point values for the exercises, scoring, and maximum total points are the same as in the regular Open class. **VETERAN DOGS (AGE 7+) MAY JUMP ANY HEIGHT THE HANDLER CHOOSES. All other dogs may jump a minimum of half their measured height.**

WILD CARD UTILITY – ENTRIES LIMITED TO 10 DOGS

The Wild Card Utility class is for any dog that is capable of performing the Utility exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in another class or classes at the trial. The Utility exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Utility A class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. (Good, yes, nice, super, great, attaboy, are some examples of praise that would be allowed.) Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or Judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The exercises will be performed in the same order as in the regular Utility A class. The point values for the exercises, scoring, and maximum total points are the same as in the regular Utility class. **VETERAN DOGS (AGE 7+) MAY JUMP ANY HEIGHT THE HANDLER CHOOSES. All other dogs may jump a minimum of half their measured height. Handlers are allowed to praise their dogs during the performance of all Utility exercises except the signal exercise.**
