

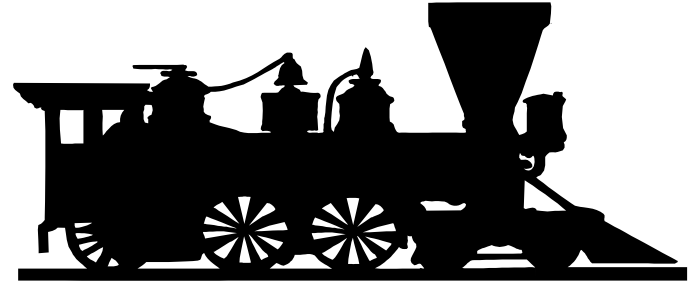

Saturday October 20, 2007**

Wild Card Open: This class is for any dog that is capable of performing the Open exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter. Owners may enter more than one dog, and dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in other classes at the trial. The Open exercises will be performed and judged according to AKC Regulations as in the regular Open A class, except that verbal praise during the exercises will not be penalized. Any additional commands to the dog, however, will be penalized. Upon check-in, tell the steward which exercise you wish to skip. The judge will excuse you from that specific exercise, while giving you a perfect score for that skipped exercise. You may, if you wish, do all exercises, without skipping any, and your score will be marked on all exercises.

Wild Card Utility: The Wild Card Utility class shall be for any dog that is capable of performing the Utility exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter. Owners may enter more than one dog; dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in the other classes at the trial. The Utility exercises will be performed and judged according to AKC Regulations as in the regular Utility A class, except that verbal praise during the exercises will not be penalized except during the principal parts of the Signal Exercise. Any additional commands to the dog, however, will be penalized. Upon check-in, tell the steward which exercise you wish to skip. The judge will excuse you from that specific exercise, while giving you a perfect score for that skipped exercise. You may, if you wish, do all exercises, without skipping any, and your score will be marked on all exercises.

Entries

- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check. Any returned check must be made good by cash or money order before the dog will be allowed into the ring.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.
- Please print or type all information on the entry form.
- Please show only dog's AKC titles on the entry form.
- Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the trial. All entries must be made on official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the Agreement and Rules.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, fax (866-370-7821), or email (nancy@pdxdogs.com) prior to the closing date.

Refunds

- No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the closing date, except in the cases of bitches that come into season. In those cases, refunds of valid entries may be obtained by providing the Trial Secretary with a veterinarian's certificate verifying that the bitch came into season after the closing date. The certificate may be mailed, provided the postmark is no later than the date prior to the day of the trial, or delivered by hand to the Trial Secretary before the start of the trial.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee.
- Entry fees will not be refunded because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization, if it is impossible to open or to complete the trial.
- Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
- If, in the opinion of the host club, the well being of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.
- Cancelled entries will be charged a \$10 processing fee.

Awards and Trophies

- Qualifying score required for all prizes in regular classes.
- The Obedience Club of Chattanooga, Inc. reserves the right to substitute a prize or trophy of equal value in the event one listed is not available from the donor.
- All awards and trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

Judging Procedures

- Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
- Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs are only allowed in rings during judging.

Site

- Crating is available indoors at this site.
- Smoking is not allowed inside the building or on the show grounds.
- All dogs must be attended or confined to their crates except when being judged.
